About The BCF

The Barzani Charity Foundation (BCF) is a non-governmental, non-political and non-profit organization that was founded in 2005 in Erbil, the capital city of the Kurdistan Region of Iraq (KRI). Mr Masrour Barzani is the head of the foundation's board of founders.

Guided by the motto of Mustafa Barzani which says that "It is an honour to serve one's own people," the BCF started its activities. The BCF has obtained official licenses from the Iraqi and Kurdistan Regional Governments and the United States licensed the BCF in 2016.

In the coordination and Management meeting of the United Nations in April of 2016, the BCF was granted Consultative Status at the United Nations Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC). It was officially licensed by the British Charity Commission in April of 2020. It was also officially registered as a charity organization in Kuwait in 2016.

The BCF's humanitarian activities have transcended Iraq's borders and it has carried out various activities to assist the most vulnerable in Turkey, Syria, Australia, Bangladesh, Yemen, Saudi Arabia, Serbia, Lebanon, and South Sudan. The BCF's projects rely on its sponsors and donors and are supported by volunteers.

The BCF's headquarters is currently based in Erbil, the capital of the Kurdistan Region of Iraq. The foundation opens offices wherever needed to implement humanitarian projects.

Visualizing a world free of poverty and forced migration in which people have equal access to education, essential services, and a protecting environment.




What we have done in 2022

In 2022, the Barzani Charity Foundation carried out 3,529 activities in 10 sectors through 1,148 employees and 115 volunteers and has been able to provide various assistance to 890,514 families (5,122,510 individuals).

Of the beneficiaries, 84,341 families (615,107 individuals) are residents of the Kurdistan Region and Iraqi provinces, as well as 686,779 families (3,590,441 individuals) in camps and outside camps, and 119,394 families (614,088 individuals) in camps and outside camps.











Humanitarian Aid by Governorates




Humanitarian Aid per number of beneficiaries from the BCF sectors



Number of families and individuals per type of beneficiaries




Number of beneficiary families and individuals, and activities by BCF offices

The BCF Working Sectors:

Barzani Charity Foundation follows international standards of organizational work to carry out its project. It works according to the sectors that have been successful in the world. In addition, it focuses on the areas of charity that our society needs on a sustainable basis.

In 2022, the Barzani Charity Foundation has worked in 10 different sectors such as food security, WASH, shelter, education and development, livelihood, cash aid, security, health, non-food items and camp coordination and man-

agement

1- Food Security

This sector operates in accordance with the guidelines of the World Food Program (WFP). The Barzani Charity Foundation works extensively in this sector, distributing hot and ready-made food and then dry food to the victims during disasters, and trying to increase food production through training and green houses.

In 2022, the foundation, whether on its own, or through donors, donor countries or international organizations, has played a major role in serving the people from refugees, IDPs, and host communities.



Delivering winter aid to the IDPs on Mount Sinjar

On the recommendation of Masrour Barzani, Prime Minister of the Kurdistan Regional Government and Chairman of the Founding Board of the Barzani Charity Foundation, the foundation delivered a convoy of flour and fuel to 1,300 displaced families on Mount Sinjar and its surroundings on January 23, 2022.



The Qurbani Meat Project









2- Education and Development Sector

First: Education

This sector focuses on education and development and consists of providing educational supplies, educational awareness courses, construction and renovation of schools and educational training centers, formal education, publishing educational instructions, and encouragement to continue education. It also provides annual educational supplies for students.

Within this sector, the Barzani Charity Foundation has paid great attention to providing educational needs, including (building schools, providing school supplies, backpacks and school supplies, opening language strengthening courses and courses to eradicate illiteracy, educational awareness and awareness on prevention of communicable viruses, etc.).




No. of beneficiary individuals according to Offices

Education and Development

Second: Renovation of 203 Schools

The Barzani Charity Foundation renovated 203 schools in the Kurdistan Region and Kurdish areas outside of the Kurdistan Regional Government.

On July 24, 2022, in a press conference attended by Alan Hama Saeed, Minister of Education, Omed Khoshnaw, Governor of Erbil, Musa Ahmad, President of the Barzani Charity Foundation announced the renovation project of 203 schools in the Kurdistan Region.

The renovation of these 203 schools came at a time when these schools had not been renovated for years, especially in some areas where ISIS had caused heavy damage to schools and the region in general.

The selection of schools for renovation was coordinated with the city education directorates and distributed among the cities as follows:



The renovation project of 203 schools was implemented at a cost of (2,058,275) dollars. The Barzani Charity Foundation implemented the project with the support of LDS Charity, Darin Group, Navella Company, One Vision International and Mahtab Company.



Providing classroom supplies

The BCF, with the support of Aghsan Al-Karma Organization, provided classroom supplies including (75 tables, 75 chairs, projecter) to Pravian kindergarten in Ble town of Barzan region on January 4, 2022...





The Barzani Charity Foundation, with the support of LDS Charity, provided various supplies to a number of schools and kindergartens under the General Directorate of Education of Sulaimaniyah Province on February 7, 2022. The supplies included (heaters, white boards, shoes, projectors, printers and some stationery supplies).

Construction and opening of a secondary school in Sheikhan village

In a ceremony attended by Mullah Mustafa Barzani, Alan Hama Saeed, Minister of Education, Head of Soran Administration, Musa Ahmed, President of the Barzani Charity Foundation, representative of B.C Company and a large number of government officials, political and organizational officials, the secondary school of (Bro Haske Tele) in Sheikhan village - Mergasur district was opened on April 5,2022.

About 250 students from seven villages around Sheikhan benefited from the school.



In a ceremony attended by Erbil Governor Omid Khoshnaw, Dr. Omar Al-Kandari, Consul General of Kuwait and Musa Ahmad, President of the Barzani Charity Foundation, inaugurated Kuwait School-2 in Pirrash district in Erbil.





Delivering Assistance to Dormitory Students in Duhok Province

The Barzani Charity Foundation provided assistance to the students who were affected by the gas explosion on November 21, 2022 and prepared hot meals for the students for 10 days. He provided clothes, materials and supplies to the dormitory students.



The laying of the foundation stone of the College of Islamic Sciences at Salahaddin University

The Barzani Charity Foundation laid the foundation stone of the College of Islamic Sciences on June 8, 2022, in a ceremony attended by Musa Ahmed, president of the foundation, representative of the Prime Minister of the Kurdistan Region Government, Erbil Governor, Consul General of Kuwait in the Kurdistan Region, president of the KRG Investment Board and president of Salahaddin University..



After the Turkish charity IHH foundation invited Barzani Charity Foundation team to participate

In the rescue training On November 21, 2022 Barzani Charity Foundation Team, who consists of 17 people, on the first day They participated in the trainings. The training in the first phase lasted for 9 days. The training covers three areas. The first: search and Rescue from difficult and high places. second:

Search, find and rescue people under Collapsed buildings caused by (earthquakes, explosions, or any other reason). Third: Search and rescue from in deep ponds and rivers. Second round of the training next year (2023) will be held in Erbil. That that coaches from IHH charity foundation comes to Kurdistan Region in the third and final round, 9 people will be selected and they will be given teaching and coaching licenses to continue training. Turkish IHH Charity Foundation Established in 1992. And it is one of the largest organizations in

Middle East and more than 1,800 volunteers are working in it. Barzani Charity Foundation has a great goal for serving the victims. So, in addition to delivery Aid and Assistance to Refugees and Displaced individuals, it is also set up for emergency and rescue operations. In coordination with the relevant government authorities and non-governmental organizations will be active in this area











The Barzani Charity Foundation (BCF), teaming up with the Public Aid Organization (PAO) and the Office of the Coordinator of International Advocacy in the Kurdistan Regional Government, organized a workshop to discuss the part of the Kurdistan Regional Plan for Human Rights related to the situation of IDPs and refugees in the Kurdistan Region on October 24, 2022.

Organizing Fourth Human Development Camping

The fourth human development camping was organized on May 10, 2022 and continued until May 16, 2022 with the participation of 60 individuals.

The fourth development camping was held under the title of "Coexistence and Reconciliation", which was a joint project of the Barzani Charity Foundation, Civil Development Organization (CDO) and the French Center for Research on Iraq (CFRI).




Health Sector

This sector focuses on the physical, mental and social health through the provision of medical services such as: (medicines, doctors, health centers, health supplies) to protect people and spread health awareness according to the guidelines of the World Health Organization (WHO).

In 2022, the Barzani Charity Foundation through donors, donor countries and international organizations, has played a major role in providing various health equipment and supplies.

Health centers in the camps

The Barzani Charity Foundation, in collaboration with a number of humanitarian organizations and donor countries, has jointly managed 2 health centers in the IDP and refugee camps in 2022, in which (medical treatment, wound dressing, laboratory tests and medicines) provided to (60.513) patients in Khazir health center and Hasan Sham health center as follows:



Providing medical supplies to three health directorates in the Kurdistan Region



On January, 31st, 2022, the Barzani Charity Foundation, in collaboration with Norwegian Maine Organization, provided 5,800 types of medicines and medical supplies to Soran Health Directorate, 6,600 to Sulaimaniyah Health Directorate and 1,900 to Chamchamal Health Directorate. The estimated cost of these donations was more than \$260,000.

Provision of 50,000 masks for university students in the Kurdistan Region

The Barzani Charity Foundation (BCF) implemented a project to provide 50,000 masks for university students on February 3, 2022 in order to protect the lives and health of students from the coronavirus.



Providing various assistance to 35 children with cancer in Kirkuk

On 15th of february The Kirkuk office of the Barzani Charity Foundation in collaboration with the Kirkuk General Directorate of Health and with the support of (Galia Company, Bright Company, International Red Cross, and Dilsoz Company) distributed aid to (35) children.



BCF Provides Medical Aid to Erbil Health Directorate



On 30th, August, 2022, The Barzani Charity Foundation (BCF) delivered medical aid, provided by the Eifel Aid Group, to the Erbil Health Directorate. The medical aid provided by the Eifel Aid Group and the BCF includes medical equipment, sanitizing items and hospital beds amounted to \$150,000.

Opening Emergency Department of Khalifan Hospital

The Barzani Charity Foundation inaugurated the emergency department of Khalifan Hospital on February 17, 2022 in a ceremony attended by the President of the Barzani Charity Foundation, the Minister of Health, and Head of Soran Independent Administration. It was constructed by the BCF at a cost of 208,000,000 Iraqi Dinars.





Lab equipment and supplies provided to Arbat camp

The BCF, with the support of LDS Charity, provided medical lab equipment and supplies to the health centre of Arbat camp in Sulaymaniyah province on November 1, 2022. 281 families benefited from the assistance (1,317 individuals)



Heart Surgery for 10 Children in Erbil

Heart disease is considered one of the most common diseases in the world. Barzani Charity Foundation continues to treat heart patients through its partners.



Project of Sending Children to Germany for Medical Treatment

The treatment of Children in Germany is a health project and an important step to treat sick children who have no hope of treatment in Kurdistan and need treatment in advanced hospitals in Germany and Europe.

This project is carried out by Peace Village International in coordination with the Barzani Charity Foundation.



Autism

The Emirates Autism Center in Erbil is a semi-charity center that provides services to low-income people free of charge. The center provides care, training and rehabilitation for children with autism. The UAE Center for Autism in Erbil was established in December 2021 by the Barzani Charity Foundation and received a license from the Kurdistan Regional Government.

In 2022, the center accommodated about 100 children, some of whom were reintegrated into mainstream schools. It currently accommodates 73 children in two shifts. 46 children in the morning (free of charge) and 27 children in the evening (semi-private).

They also have about 50 teachers and trainers with Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) certificate, a therapy based on the science of learning and behavior.


On Monday, September 12, 2022, a graduation ceremony was held for 6 students who were sent to regular school and continue their education like any other normal child.






4. Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH)


We provide the number and types of beneficiaries of water projects in 2022:





Livelihood Sector

This sector is a long-term program to develop individuals' skills for the purpose of education, talent creation, job creation and income generation for individuals and families in times of crisis. Annualy, hundreds of people participate in the courses of computer, sewing, plumbing, electricity, food production, handicrafts, etc., at the the cultural and vocational training centers of the Barzani Charity Foundation. It also conducts the project (cash for work) for its construction projects.





Cultural and Vocational Centers

The Barzani Charity Foundation provides training and invest in local residents, refugees and IDPs in the camps in the Kurdistan Region provinces through the cultural and vocational centers it manages in coordination with a number of international organizations.

In 2022, the foundatiob carried out 959 activities through those centers to provide various educational, vocational and awareness activities. A large number of participants benefited from courses such as (computer programs, documentaries and memoirs, seminars and workshops, health care, art and craft, barber training, student empowerment, tree planting campaign, sports activities, sewing, languages.



6. Cash Assistance Sector

The sector works on a program to provide financial assistance to provide services and basic necessities for low-income families.

The Barzani Charity Foundation started distributing cash assistance to orphans in 2009 as part of the project of Orphan Care. So far, 15,347 orphans have benefited from receiving monthly financial assistance. In another project, widows receive monthly financial assistance.

This project was further developed and in 2012, with the help of local charities in Kurdistan, it benefited more children have lost their fathers.

In 2022, the Barzani Charity Foundation, with the assistance of charity personalities, donors, foreign countries and international organizations, has played a major role in providing assistance to orphans and women. It has constantly tried to find more donors and sponsors for this project so that they can benefit as many people as possible. Here are the number and types of beneficiaries according to the type of projects, along with the parties, organizations and countries that have cooperated and sponsored the projects:




First: Cash Assistance to Displaced and Refugee Families


First Round Distribution: 10,816 Orphan Children

No. of orphans and Distributed Amount according to Place of Distribution






:Second Round distribution


Orphan Care Project – Kurdistan .1

Distribution 1: Barzani Charity Foundation's Orphan Care Project was carried out with the cooperation and support of business people and donors. In 2022, 2,868 orphans benefited from the project, amounting to 860,400 US dollars.






Orphan Care Project – Polish Charities

The project has received international attention, which has led a number of Polish charity people to provide financial assistance to children within the Barzani Charity Foundation's orphan care project.

On July 19, 2021, the Barzani Charity Foundation with the assistance of a number of donors from Poland assisted (44) orphans in the first phase and the total amount was (6,750 US dollars. In the second phase, the financial assistance consisting of 11,850 US dollars was distributed to 48 children in Erbil province.



7. Non-Food (NFI) Sector

Barzani Charity Foundation works on providing everyday necessities to low-income people. These include: (kitchen supplies, beddings, heating and cooling appliances, clothing, etc.)

Delivery of a convoy of winter aid to the refugees on Mount Shingal

Providing the Needs of 700 Students from Sinjar Living in Dormitories

The Barzani Charity Foundation (BCF) assited 700 students from Sinjar who were sheltered in the dormitory of Duhok University due to the deteriorating situation in their areas.



Third: Emergency Relief

The Barzani Charity Foundation in collaboration with Erbil Governorate provided hot food and fuel to families affected by the flood in a number of neighbourhoods in Erbil including (Zilan City, Pirash, Sebirdan, Bakhtiari, Bahrka, Hawleri Nwe and Shawes) on January 13, 2022. In addition to that, the foundation, teaming up with the Erbil Joint Cri-

sis Coordination Center and Galia Group of Companies, distributed aid includinging (heaters, blankets, mattresses, food, carpets and stoves) to (205) affected families on January 17, 2022.

In Duhok province, the BCF distributed various types of assistanceto(2,905)flood-affected families. The aid included (2,790) food parcels, (244,700) liters of kerosene, (2,218) heaters, (2,340) square meters of carpets, of which each family was provided with 52 sq meters, (11,700) pillows, (11,700) mattresses, (12,740) blankets, (500) refrigerators, (500) stoves, (500) washing machines provided by Barz Group of Companies, (400) propane gas bottles, and (14,720) hot meals.







8. Camp Management and Camp Coordination (CCCM) Sector

This sector consists of the management and coordination of camps under the guidance and in partnership with the UNHCR and the Joint Crisis Coordination Center to provide services to camp residents.

Barzani Charity Foundation took over the administration of refugee and IDP camps in Erbil and Duhok provinces.

In 2022, the foundation managed (20) IDP camps in Duhok province, (9) refugee camps and (1) camp for host communities in Erbil province.

Protection Sector

The sector works to protect threatened individuals from physical and psychological abuse and help them overcome the fear through training and protection of human rights, children's rights and women's rights. It pays full attention to social awareness to avoid sexual assault, crime and gender-based violence.

Barzani Charity Foundation pays attention to the protection of women and children through its centers inside and outside the camps. the foundation works to keep victims away from social problems and mental and physical violence. Within this sector, the foundation has offered various courses in cultural and vocational centers. In 2022, it has played a major role in this field through donors, foreign countries and international organizations.




10. Shelter

This sector works on sheltering displaced pesons and refugees in times of crisis by providing tents, caravans, building concrete houses, renovation of houses in war-devastated areas, building reception halls and shelters for victims.

In 2014, the Barzani Charity Foundation managed its first camp in Erbil province. Until 2022, in coordination with the UNHCR, it manages 30 refugee and IDP camps in Erbil and Duhok provinces.

In 2022, the Barzani Charity Foundation through the Crisis Coordination Center of Erbil and Duhok, UNHCR, donors, foreign countries and international organizations, has played a major role in creating a decent living situation in the camps for IDPs, refugees and host communities).



Replacement of 900 Tents for IDPs in Shekhan Camp

The Barzani Charity Foundation and the Consul General of Armenia in Erbil signed a memorandum or understaning on October 10, 2022, to replace 900 tents for IDPs in Shekhan camp in Duhok Province.


Disability Support Project

The project of providing various equipment and supplies for people with disabilities is one of the sectors that Barzani Charity Foundation has worked on. This project began in 2015 by a joint agreement with the LDS Charity. The aid provided include wheelchairs, toilet seats, walking frames, crutches, three- and four-wheel walkers, etc. In 2022, 1,068 people with disabilities have been assisted in Kalar, Duhok, Erbil, Halabja, Kirkuk, Nineveh, Sulaymaniyah and Garmian areas.

The Barzani Charity Foundation took the opportunity to give its own appreciation award to (LDS) organization, for the continuous help and assistance they give to the Barzani Charity Foundation, as they have been a constant helper in most of Barzani Charity Foundation's projects regarding disabled persons.

In the ceremony, school bags and

stationeries were distributed by the Barzani Charity Foundation's employees to disabled students.

According to Iraq's Central Data foundation, there are nearly 6 million disabled persons living in Iraq, and 100,000 are living in the Kurdistan region.

First: Providing 420 residential units to the families of martyrs


The construction of 420 housing units in Roj City in the center of Duhok province took two years and is considered the largest project ever built for the proud families of martyrs. The project cost \$29,400,000. 1763 people have benefited from it.

The project consists of 25 20-storey buildings built in a modern style and architectural standards. 368 housing units were distributed in the first phase and another 52 units will be distributed in the second phase. The project provides all services, including 24-hour electricity, continuous cleaning, surveillance camera systems, school, hospital, mosque, mall and markets, gyms and transportation lines.











A Team of BCF Participates in Rescue and Emergency Training in Turkey



On November 23, 2022, a BCF team consisting of 17 people, participated in the rescue and emergency training, provided by Turkish iHH. The training lasted for nine days in the first phase which covered three areas: search and rescue in difficult and high places, search, find, and rescue people under collapsed buildings and search and rescue in deep ponds and rivers.








Assisting 124 Ukrainian Refugees


A Delegation from Peace Winds Visits Barzani Charity Foundation

BCF Delegation Visits iHH to Boost Collaboration



BCF Attends Annual Conference for Ethnic Minorities in Geneva


